

The Dormitory Authority of the State of New York ("DASNY" or the "Dormitory Authority") is in receipt of the Rochester Joint Schools Construction Board State Environmental Quality Review ("SEQR") Lead Agency Request Letter, dated December 1, 2010, for the Rochester Schools Modernization Program ("RSMP") – Phase I project as part of the Expanding Our Children's Education and Learning ("EXCEL") Program.
