Dear Parent/Guardian,

I hope your day is off to a promising start. Recently your student was impacted by a lesson that was taught during a Social Studies class here at School of the Arts which took place Tuesday April 26th. The school is still gathering all of the facts, but we want to assure you that as a SOTA School family, we are taking proactive measures to support our students, families and surrounding community. One way we are offering support is by having the RocRestorative Team into the building to facilitate community-trauma circles. Circles are a protocol used to allow **ALL** participants to have a space to convey what is on their mind if they would like to do so. If students do not want to verbalize how they are feeling, they will not be forced to do so. We will be providing this support by facilitating circles with those that would like to participate by doing the following:

- -Offering those impacted a space to articulate what their experience was or is currently.
- -Providing an opportunity for participants to convey how they have been impacted by the lesson taught.
- -What do you personally need to happen for this scenario to be made right?
- -What do you need from the adults here at SOTA or from the district to help you cope with this unfortunate circumstance?
