


MEETING NORMS

- 3rd marking period report cards sent this week

 - K-5 students
 - Pass (P) or Not Applicable (NA)
 - 6 – 12 students
 - Pass with Distinction (PD) – grade equivalent of 85-100
 - Pass (P) – grade equivalent of 65-84
 - Incomplete (I)

- Opportunities and support for makeup work will continue through rest of year and summer
