

Preparing for your Child's COVID-19 Immunization: Parent and Guardian Guide



As patient eligibility expands, we are excited to be able to partner with local schools to provide COVID-19 immunizations, allowing you the opportunity to protect additional members of your family! Children 12 years and older are now able to get the 2-dose Pfizer vaccine. This guide will help you through the process of preparing for your child's upcoming school clinic with Walgreens.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE SCHOOL VACCINATION DAY FOR MINORS |

- **It is recommended that parent/guardian be present at time of vaccination of a minor (anyone under the age of 18 years).** This is important because having the parent/guardian present allows our pharmacists to answer COVID-19 immunization questions or concerns directly.
- If the parent/guardian cannot be present at the time of vaccination, consent can be provided ahead of the school's vaccination day and your child may receive Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine on the day of the clinic. Please review the following section to understand what is required for parents/guardians to provide consent if you are unable to attend the immunization clinic.

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE CONSENT |

- Parents/guardians who cannot be present at the time of vaccination of a minor can provide consent by completing the following:
 - **Review the Pfizer COVID-19 Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) Fact Sheet:** This fact sheet provides important vaccine specific information allowing you to make an informed decision about vaccination.
 - **Provide contact information:** In the phone number field of Section A of the Vaccine Administration Record (VAR), parents/guardians must provide a phone number they can be reached at on the day of vaccination. This is to allow the immunizer to call parents/guardians if any questions come up at the time of vaccination.
 - **Sign the Vaccine Administration Record (VAR):** After reviewing the above documents, the parent/guardian must sign the VAR form (section C) confirming consent. Please see the **VAR Guide** for instructions on how to complete this form.
- If you have any clinical questions after reviewing Pfizer's EUA fact sheet on their COVID-19 vaccine ahead of your child's vaccination, you can reach a pharmacist at 1-866-432-9070.
 - Any questions around clinic planning or coordination should be brought to your child's school directly.
- If you would like to be vaccinated along with your child, please check with the school to confirm they can accommodate.
