**Test and Quizzes** - Test and Quizzes will reflect course content we have covered. There will be 2 to 3 test each MP. There are no makeup tests; test corrections or Extra-credit in this class.

**Class Preparation** - It is the responsibility of the student to attend class with a notebook, pencil/pen and TI -89 calculator.

**Home work** - You Home work is an essential part of the learning process. Success on this exam depends on your ability to solve difficult problems on a routine basis. Home work will be assigned everyday. I do not accept late homework unless a student is legally absent. I cannot stress enough the importance of doing EVERY homework assignment.

**Note Book** - Each student is expected to have a three ring binder with blank sheets for note taking, hand out and homework.

**Math League:** 10 points are added to any test for participating in a Math League.

**Attendance policy** - You must have 93% attendance in order to be eligible to pass a MP. If you are absent, it is your responsibility to catch up with the missed work and assignments. In case of absence, any homework, tests or other assignments due the day you were absent are expected to be completed the day you return.

**Grading:** Grads for MP 1to 5 will be computed as follows:      Test/Quizzes/Projects 90%  
Home work 10%

There will be an in class Final Exam in the week before the College Board Exam.  
Grade for the 6<sup>th</sup> MP will come from Projects and presentations.  
The Final score for the class will be 75% of the average of all 6 MP and 25%of the Final Exam
