How to Send AP Scores to Colleges:

- Seniors should send an official score report to their college for review and to grant credit
 - June 20th Deadline to submit request
- Each student can send AP scores to 1 college for free through their CollegeBoard account.

 - Click on “My AP”
 - In the top right of the page, click “My AP Profile”
 - Click the score send tab
 - Enter your college and submit
