### 3 points (100%) if ALL of the statements below are true for you:

- I was on time to class or I brought a pass when I was late.
- I have all the materials I need for class.
- I followed classroom norms and procedures.
- I stayed on-task without having to be asked.

### 2 points (70%) if 1-2 of the statements below are true for you:

- I was late to class and did not have a pass.
- I have some of my materials, but not all of them.
- I had to be reminded to follow class norms and procedures.
- I was on-task most of the time, but not all of the time.

## 1 point (50%) if 3-4 of the statements below are true for you:

- I was late to class and did not have a pass.
- I am missing most of my materials necessary for class.
- I have ignored most of our classroom norms and procedures.
- I was off-task much of the time.

# O points if ANY of the statements below are true for you:

- I was absent from class for any reason and did not make up my work within one week
- I repeatedly interrupted the teaching and learning process.

3 points per day x the # of days you had English class = max points for the week. Your total points for the week divided by max points for the week = your score.

Ex:

If you have English 3 times in a week, your max points for the week would be 9.

If your daily scores for that week were 3, 2, and 1 (total of 6) and it was divided by 9 (your max points for the week), your grade for the week would be 66%.
