About this booklet

This booklet provides information on schools and community-based Prekindergarten sites available for 2021-22, along with instructions on how to register your child.

Preschool for 3-and 4-year-olds

Universal Prekindergarten (UPK) program is open to all City resident children who will be three or four years old on or before December 1, 2021. All programs are full-day (6 hours).

Free Universal Pre-K

When your child enters Universal Prekindergarten programs in the Rochester City School District, he or she becomes part of a learning community that nurtures individual growth and provides a strong foundation for lifelong learning.

The Rochester Pre-K experience offers an instructional program taught by certified teachers to prepare your child for school. Children who participate:

- Learn socialization skills through group activities
- Experience reading and writing readiness activities
- Are better prepared for school success
- Are more likely to attain higher levels of education

What To Expect

Your child will spend 6 hours at a nearby Pre-K program.

Your child care subsidies for before- and after-school, as well as breaks and summers, will not be lost when participating in the Pre-K program.

If transportation is not offered at your location, your provider can issue a free bus pass to the parent. The child rides free. These are 31-day passes so they can also be used outside of the Pre-K time period.

Covid Guidelines

Families will have the option to be fully remote or participate in a hybrid learning schedule. Students that are fully remote will learn via zoom and the education app, Seesaw. Students who are on a hybrid schedule will be in person two days out of the week. Before leaving the house, every student should be screened for COVID-19 by asking the following questions:

- Have you been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
- Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
- Do you have a temperature of 100.0°F or higher?
- Do you have any new or worsening symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, sore throat, cough, sudden loss of taste or smell, muscle or body aches, headache, congestion or a runny nose, diarrhea or vomiting)?
- Have you traveled internationally or from a restricted state per the New York State Travel Advisory in the past 14 days?

If your student answers yes to any of the above questions, you must notify the school nurse and keep your child home.

Upon arrival to the school, students will be COVID-19 screened, have their temperature taken and be instructed to social distance from arrival to departure. Throughout



the day, students will have designated mask breaks and will not be required to wear a mask while eating breakfast or lunch.

Class sizes have been reduced to eight students per cohort to be in compliance with COVID-19 protocols. Cohort A will attend in-person learning Mondays and Tuesdays, Cohort B will attend in person learning on Thursdays and Fridays. Wednesday, both cohorts will be attending class virtually while the classrooms are being disinfected. In the classroom, students will be assigned a socially distanced learning pod that will have all of the materials needed for the day. Materials within the learning pods will not be shared between students.

Bilingual Education

Bilingual programs are offered to three and four year old students who speak Spanish or who have family members who speak Spanish in their home. Students receive instruction in Spanish and English according to their needs. The focus of the bilingual prekindergarten programs is to support language learning in English and Spanish to promote bilingualism. What makes it possible for RCSD to offer a bilingual Prekindergarten is the number of appropriately aged children who speak Spanish.

A goal of the bilingual prekindergarten program is to produce bilingual/bi-literate students who will excel in their academic endeavors. The ability to read, write and speak the English language makes a difference in the quality of life that one can aspire to in the United States. We aim to produce productive citizens who aspire to graduate from high school and pursue a college education. It all begins in the pre-kindergarten years when the basic foundation is laid.

Four schools offer full-day bilingual education to 4-year-old students at the following locations: Schools No. 9, 17, 22 and 33. School No. 22 offers full-day bilingual education to 3-year-old students.

Multilingual Programs

Schools No. 5, 15, and 50 offer multilingual programs.

Special Education

The Special Education Department provides special educational services for eligible children who live in the City of Rochester. These services are provided at no cost to parents for all students between ages 3 and 5.

Preschool special education services include Special Education Itinerant Teacher (SEIT) support, a special class in an integrated or separate setting, and related services, such as Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy and Vision services.

Any child with an IEP who attends a Rochester City School District school will receive services, provided by an RCSD employee when possible. Students enrolled in our community-based sites will have services provided by an outside organization.

If your child received Early Intervention Services as an infant or toddler up to age 3 and may still need special education, your service coordinator will assist you with the process to transition your child into preschool special education services.

If your child did not receive Early Intervention services, but has difficulty talking, moving around, thinking or learning, or is facing physical or behavioral challenges, you may make a referral to the Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE). 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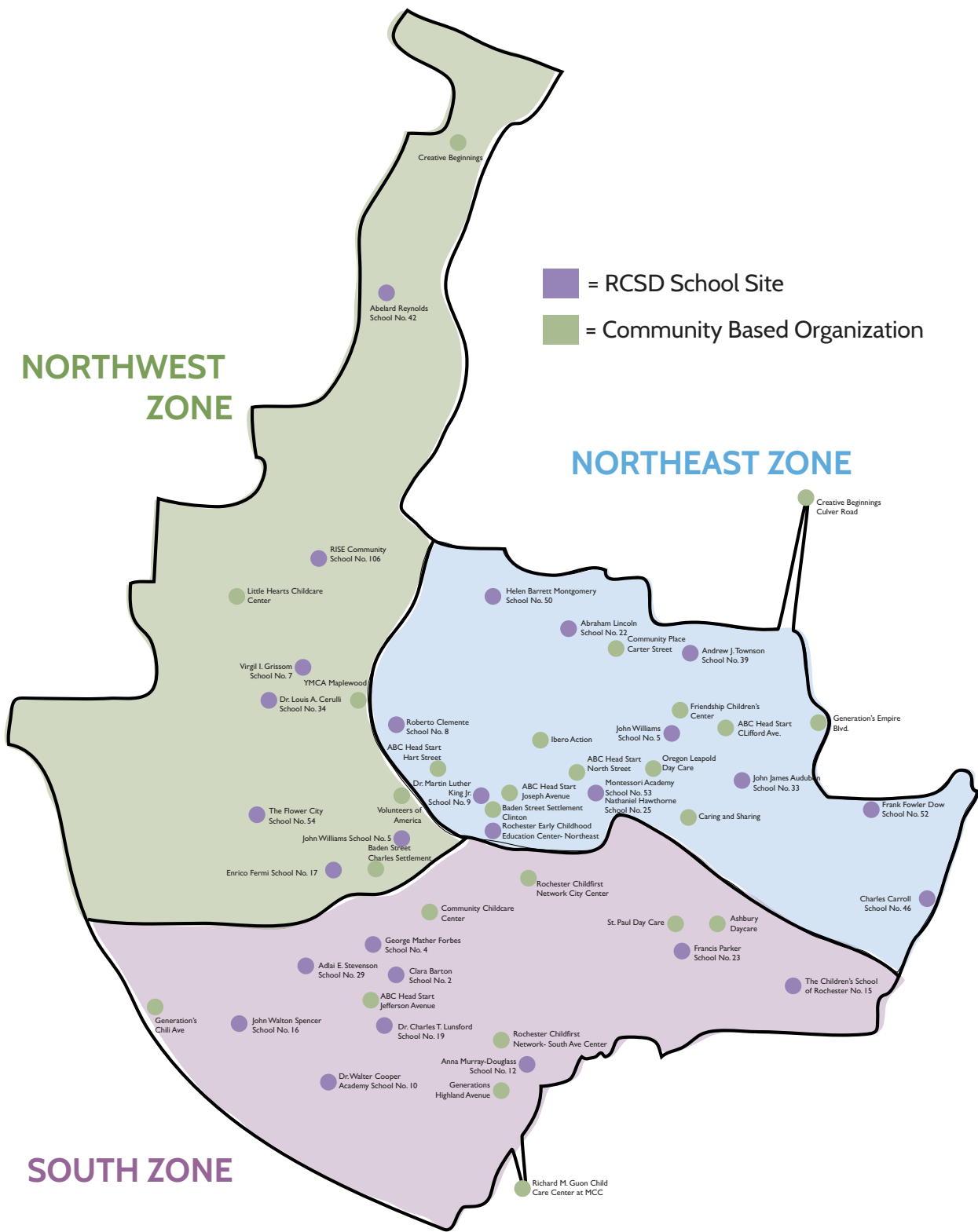
