Topic: Seed Planting

Ideas for follow-up	Movements	Target Skills
Materials for group: • Chair or low table to jump down from. • Masking tape to place "X" on floor to indicate where to land after jumping down. • Towel • Squirt bottle filled with water. A large squirt bottle filled with water provides strengthening to a child's arms due to its weight.	Activity performed by 2-children at a time. One child is the "seed" and stands on the chair/low table. Second child is the "farmer" who has the towel (dirt / soil), squirt bottle (water / rain) near him. Farmer plants the seed by telling seed to "jump in the hole". Seed jumps down and lays down so farmer can cover him with the towel (dirt). The farmer using the squirt bottle, (3-squirts), to give the seed water. The farmer clasps hands above his hand pretending to give sunlight / light to the seed. Farmer takes the towel away as the seed grows into a plant. The seed that is now a plant, kneels and then knee walks away. The 2-children switch roles. The other children in the group, verbally cue the seed & farmer by saying jump down, cover with "dirt", seed needs water & light, then grow to a plant.	 Reinforces seed planting by acting out. Sequencing. Works on vocabulary (seed, dirt/soil, water / rain, sunlight/ light, farmer). Strength. Balance. Coordination.

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
