Message from the Executive Director, Dr. Robin Hooper

Welcome to Preschool to our students and families! Our prekindergarten enrollment of three and four year old students has exceeded 3,200 students to date. Family involvement in a child's education is important to a child's success in school and life. There are some important opportunities for involvement coming up that families will want to be sure to put on their calendars.

Our <u>Read 1000 Books Before Kindergarten Campaign</u> is underway! Thank you for reading aloud to your child every day! Ask your child's teacher for bubble sheets to keep track of all the books you are reading with your child! Research shows children who read 1,000 books before entering kindergarten become better readers!

Kindergarten and Prekindergarten registration for Fall 2018 will begin in **January 2018.** An event is being planned where school representatives will be available to answer questions and placement staff will be available to take registrations for prekindergarten and kindergarten. Look for information in our next newsletter! Registering early will give you the best selection of schools and programs.

Families of four-year-old students are invited to attend the **Transition to Kindergarten Family Event on Saturday**, **April 28th from 10 AM—2:00 PM at 500 Webster Ave.** Families will have an opportunity to engage in learning activities with their children, attend workshops and receive free learning tools to take home with recommended activities for learning at home.

Pre-k families have a variety of ways to connect with their child's education. Before each vacation break three-year-old and four-year-old prekindergarten students will receive **Take Home Books** to read during the break and to keep for their home libraries. These books can be read multiple times and counted toward each student's goal of **reading 1,000 books before kindergarten**. Families who are speakers of languages other than English are invited to participate in Bilingual Council Meetings held on the second Tuesday of each month.

I love to read! And I love books! I really love to read!


And I know that reading books will help me to succeed!







