# About this booklet

This booklet provides information on schools and community-based Prekindergarten sites available for 2019-20, along with instructions on how to register your child.

# Preschool for 3-and-4-year-olds

Universal Prekindergarten (ÚPK) program is open to all city resident children who will be three or four years old on or before December 1, 2019. Most programs are full-day (6 hours) and there are a few half-day programs (2.5 hours) also available.

# Free Universal Pre-K

When your child enters Universal Prekindergarten programs in the Rochester City School District, he or she becomes part of a learning community that nurtures individual growth and provides a strong foundation for lifelong learning.

The Rochester Pre-K experience offers an instructional program taught by certified teachers to prepare your child for school. Children who participate:

- Learn socialization skills through group activities
- Experience reading and writing readiness activities
- · Are better prepared for school success
- Are more likely to attain higher levels of education

# What To Expect

Your child may spend 6 hours at a nearby Pre-K program, or a limited number of four year old UPK half-day 2.5 hour placements in either morning or afternoon sessions.

Your child care subsidies for before- and afterschool, as well as breaks and summers will not be lost when participating in the Pre-K program.

If transportation is not offered at your location, your provider can issue a free bus pass to the parent. The child rides free. These are 31 day passes so they can also be used outside of the Pre-K time period.

# Universal Pre-K for 4-year-olds

Full- and half-day programs for 4-year-olds:

You can choose from the many community- based organizations that offer our Universal Pre-K program, some of which provide bus transportation and/or wrap around care before and after class. Register early to ensure seats are available at your preferred location.

For all Community-Based Organizations, apply at the location.

## For all numbered schools:

• You can select from any school that offers Pre-K in the city.

# **Bilingual Education**

Bilingual programs are offered to four year old students and are part of the Universal Pre-K program. Children in the RCSD Bilingual Prekindergarten program receive instruction in Spanish, their native language. These building blocks are being formed with an understanding that eventually the skills will transfer to English language instruction. We want students to have a solid background in Spanish as well as English. What makes it possible for RCSD to offer a bilingual Prekindergarten is the number of appropriately aged children who speak Spanish.

A goal of the bilingual prekindergarten program is to produce bilingual/bi-literate students who will excel in their academic endeavors. The ability to read, write and speak the English language makes a difference in the quality of life that one can aspire to in the United States. We aim to produce productive citizens who aspire to graduate from high school and pursue a college education. It all begins in the pre-kindergarten years when the basic foundation is laid.

Three school sites offer full-day bilingual education to 4-year-old students at the following sites: Schools No. 9, 22, and 33. There is a dual language Spanish/English pre-K program at School No. 17.

# Speak Spanish?

If your child speaks Spanish and if you are interested in the District's bilingual program, call the Language Assessment and Placement Center, 131 West Broad Street, at 262-8241.

A language specialist will help determine the program that will best meet your child's language needs.

# **Multilingual Programs**

Schools No. 5, 15, and 50 offer multilingual programs.

# **Special Education**

The District Special Education Department provides special educational services for eligible children who live in the City of Rochester. These services are provided at no cost to parents for all students between ages 3 and 5.

Preschool special education services include Special Education Itinerant Teacher (SEIT) support, a special class in an integrated or separate setting, and related services, such as Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy and Vision services.

Any child with an IEP who attends a Rochester City School District school will receive services, provided by an RCSD employee when possible. Students enrolled in our community-based sites will be provided for by outside organizations.

If your child received Early Intervention Services as an infant or toddler up to age 3 and may still need special education, your service coordinator will assist you with the process to transition your child into preschool special education services.

If your child did not receive Early Intervention services, but has difficulty talking, moving around, thinking or learning, or is facing physical or behavioral challenges, you may make a referral to the Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE). The CPSE in Rochester City School District will assist you in completing the referral process. Call (585) 262-8451 for more information.
