Resolution 2019-20: 69 Acceptance of 2018-2019 Independent Financial Audit

WHEREAS, the Ro chester Schoo I Facilit ies Modernization Program Act (" the Act") est ablished the Rochester Joint Schoo Is Construction Board (" RJSCB" or "Boa rd"), a sev en voting member board consisting of eq ual representation by the City of Rochester ("Cit y") and the Rochester City Schoo I District (" District"), as well as a mem ber joint ly selected by the City and the District; and

WHEREAS, under the Act, the RJSCB has certain enumerated powers to act as agent for the District, the City, or both; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB's General Counse I recommend ed to the RJSCB's M/WBE and Services Procur ement Committee (the "Committee") that a Fin ancial Audit of the RJSCB's financial commitments, o b ligations, and int ernal controls be performed on an ann ual basis; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB's Treasurer recommended that the RJSCB participate with the City and the District in a Request for Pro posa Is (" RFP") by the City for financial audit ing services, begi nning 2012-2013 (Resolution 2012 - 2013: 123); and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB is con sidered a blended component of the Dist rict's budget which is a part of the overall City's budget, and there are efficiencies in having the same firm perform the RJSCB's, the District's, and the City's annual financial audit s; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB's Executive Director worked with the RJSCB's general counsel, the City, and the District to coordinat e appropriate language to be included in the City's RFP document; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB's port ion of the RFP was bid as a separate line item so that the RJSCB could review the cost and determine if its audit should be included in the final award of the financial auditing services; and

WHEREAS, the City received three proposal responses to the RFP on the date specified in the RFP, and promptly provided co pie s to the RJSCB's Execut ive Director for review; and

WHEREAS, the City, the District, and the RJSCB participated in a proposal review meeting on March 22, 2013, where details of each proposal were discussed along with the qualifications of each firm; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB's Executive Director recomm ended to the Committee on March 28, 2013, that the RJSCB support the City and Distri ct's decision to award based on the merits and qualifications of the best firm, although it may mean that the specific pricing included for the RJSCB's work may not be the lowest price; and

WHEREAS, the City and Dist rict identified the firm Freed Maxick & Batt aglia as the most quali fied firm to provide the requeste d financial auditing servi ces, and the RJSCB accepted the City's recommendation to award the contract to Freed Maxick & Battaglia (Resolution 2012-2013: 164); and

WHEREAS, Freed Maxick & Battag lia has now com pleted the financial audit report (the "Report") for the t ime period ending June 30, 2019 (att ached to this resolution), and the RJSCB's Executive Director and its General Counsel have review ed and considered the Report ; and

WHEREAS, the RJSCB's Chair has recommended to the RJSCB that it accepts the Report, and the RJSCB dis cussed the recommendat ion and considered the Report at its regular Board meeting on December 9, 2019.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The RJSCB h ereby accepts the 2018-2019 Financial Audit Report in the form attached to this Resoluti on.
