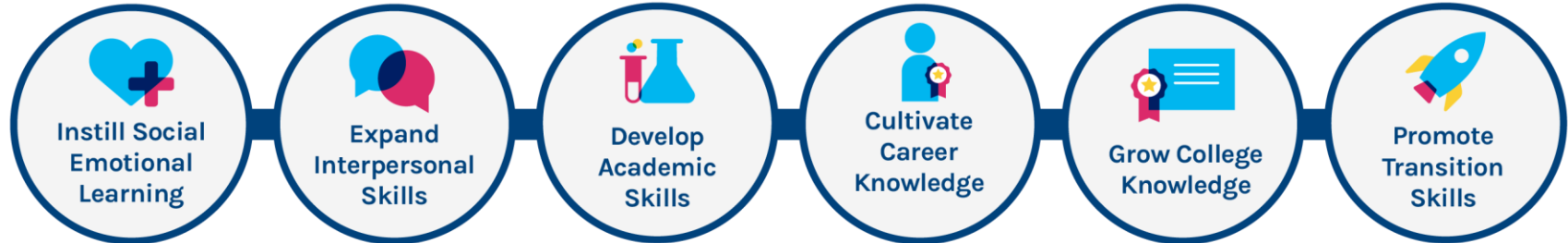

Meeting Student Needs to Improve Outcomes:



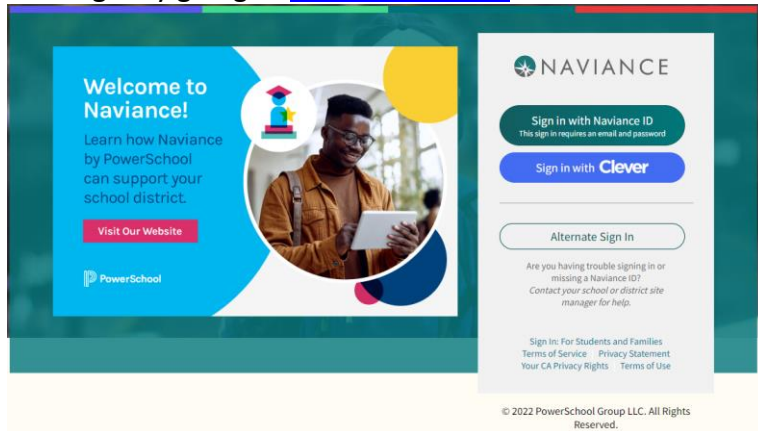
The Naviance College, Career, and Life Readiness (CCLR) Framework is designed to further college and career readiness programs for middle and high school students.

Tips, Tricks, and Helpful Resources:

- Review previous year's data to make informed decisions about scholars.
- Work with teachers to create a Naviance schedule in order to complete classroom presentations.
- Review lessons plans (Naviance Companion Guide) and collaborate with teachers to conduct activities.
- Provide a Naviance tour and ensure students are aware of how to login and use the site.
- Couple Naviance lesson plans with pre-existing counseling activities (report card review & academic setting).
- Use the aligned Naviance curriculum under each activity as a pre-lesson, if needed.
- Incorporate road trip nation videos into your daily tasks. Share weekly videos with teachers and students.
- Share videos on school site.
- Help convey messages about resiliency and strength via videos.

1. Staff login by going to ID.Naviance.com:

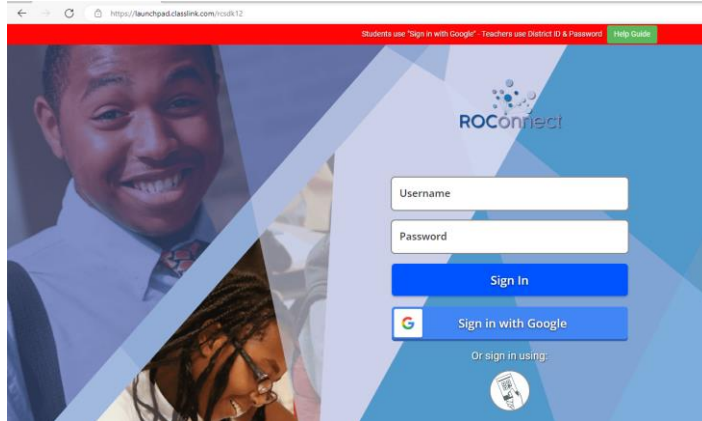


2. Click Sign in with Naviance ID
