Triangles Around Us!

Assignment:

There are triangles all over the place! We see them every day! Below are some triangles that we often run into!



For this assignment, look throughout your house to see if you can find objects that are triangles! Once you have found some, pick one that you would like to draw!

Instructions and an example are on the next page! There is also a triangle practice sheet listed underneath this lesson on the teacher page. You can print that page, or practice drawing triangles on a blank sheet of paper before drawing your final piece!

When you do begin on your final piece, try to start with the triangle by making it large, and in the center of your piece, like in the example below. This puts **emphasis** on the triangle, which means, bringing our attention or focus onto the triangle! When you draw something very large, or put it in the middle of your artwork, it is very easy to see, and it stands out, so it brings people's attention or focus to it!


Begin with the triangle shape. Try to put it large, and in the center of the page. Next, continue to outline things that you see on it, like other shapes or patterns. Lastly, fill it in with any other details you see, like color, texture, etc!
