
Drawing with Shapes and Emphasis!

Many objects which we see every day have recognizable shapes such as triangles!




For today's assignment, look around your house and try to find objects that have two or more of the following shapes in them!




We will practice drawing objects we see by drawing their shapes.


Please send me pictures of your art if you can! I would love to see them!

For example, I found a pen in my house that has a rectangle and a triangle.







As you draw your object, look for the shapes that make up the object and draw them first!



Then, you can add some basic detail by adding other shapes or outlines you see



After this, you can put more details, by adding things like color or texture.




As you create your drawings, please also draw your object large and in the middle of the picture! This puts **emphasis** on it, which means, bringing our attention or focus onto it! When you draw something very large, or put it in the middle of your artwork, it is very easy to see, and it stands out, so it brings people's attention or focus to it!

There are other ways to put **emphasis** on things in a piece of art as well. One Method, is to draw the object you are trying to put **emphasis** on, in a different color than the other things in the picture!

Try using color to put emphasis on the thing you draw! Some ways to do this are listed below!

- You can draw the background black and white, and have your object be in color.
- You can draw with warm colors in the background and have the object be a cool color, or The other way around!
- You can draw your object a color and have the background be its complementary color! complementary colors are green and red, or orange and blue, or yellow and purple!
