



Often, communities share food and flowers in gardens. We have Libraries to share books, and mailboxes to share mail with people. If you could create a place (or many places) to share something with people, what would it be? What would you be sharing with people? How would the place or places allow you to share it?

1. For this project, try to brainstorm something you would like to be able to share with people. It could be objects like toys, or something less concrete, like ideas or emotions (for example, sharing something like happiness.)
2. Next, think about what kind of place or system you would set up to share it with people. Places like libraries, where we share books, or museums, where we share art, are often one single building people can enter. Mailboxes are millions of places, where people can share by sending each other things. Similarly, we can share conversations through the wires and signals on telephones and computers.
3. Lastly, think about how you will visually show the process of how your objects, ideas, or emotions, are shared with people. Maybe you can show objects attached to a wire going between two people, or maybe you could show somebody going to many different areas to give people things. Maybe you could show someone at some kind of stand where they are handing things out.

If the thing you are sharing is an idea or emotion, you can come up with a symbol for it that you can show being given and received. For example, if you were sharing “inspiration,” you could use a symbol of a light bulb to represent it, and you could show someone giving out light bulbs.
