

Drawing with Triangles!

Assignment:

Last week we practiced drawing triangles, and drew a big triangle in our party hat artwork!

Look at the drawing below and see if you can see any of the triangles in the picture!



The triangles are outlined in the drawing below. Check to see if you found them!



As you can see, many objects which we see every day are triangles!



For this assignment, you will draw a picture with a triangle in it, but this time you will choose what kind of triangular object you draw!

First, practice drawing triangles for a few minutes like we did last time. You can look at the triangles on this page, and practice on a blank piece of paper, or you can print out the triangle tracing practice page we did last time and do it again! (it is listed under this lesson on the teacher page)

Next, think about objects that are triangles that you could include in a picture.

You could draw yourself holding something triangular, or standing near something that is a triangle. You can also just focus on the triangle, and draw the triangular object really big and in the center of the paper like we did with our triangle hat last time!

To help you brainstorm a triangle object you can include in your artwork, here are some ideas!

~Look around your house, and see if you see any objects that have triangles in them

~Talk with someone in your house to see if they can help you think of, or look for triangles around you!

~You can also look at the examples on this page to help you think of ideas!
