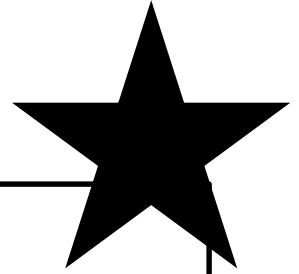
Reading tip of the month...
