On Tuesday, May 23, 2023, 40 students from East High School, Edison Career and Technology High School, James Monroe Upper School, Joseph C. Wilson Magnet High School Commencement Academy, Northeast College Preparatory High School, School of the Arts, School Without Walls are visiting the State Capitol in Albany to meet with legislators and advocate for continued support for Advanced Placement.

These students and their teachers will join others from various school districts across New York to urge lawmakers to maintain funding to cover AP exam fees for low-income students and to expand access in schools with few or no AP courses. The students will attend meetings with members of the local state delegation.
