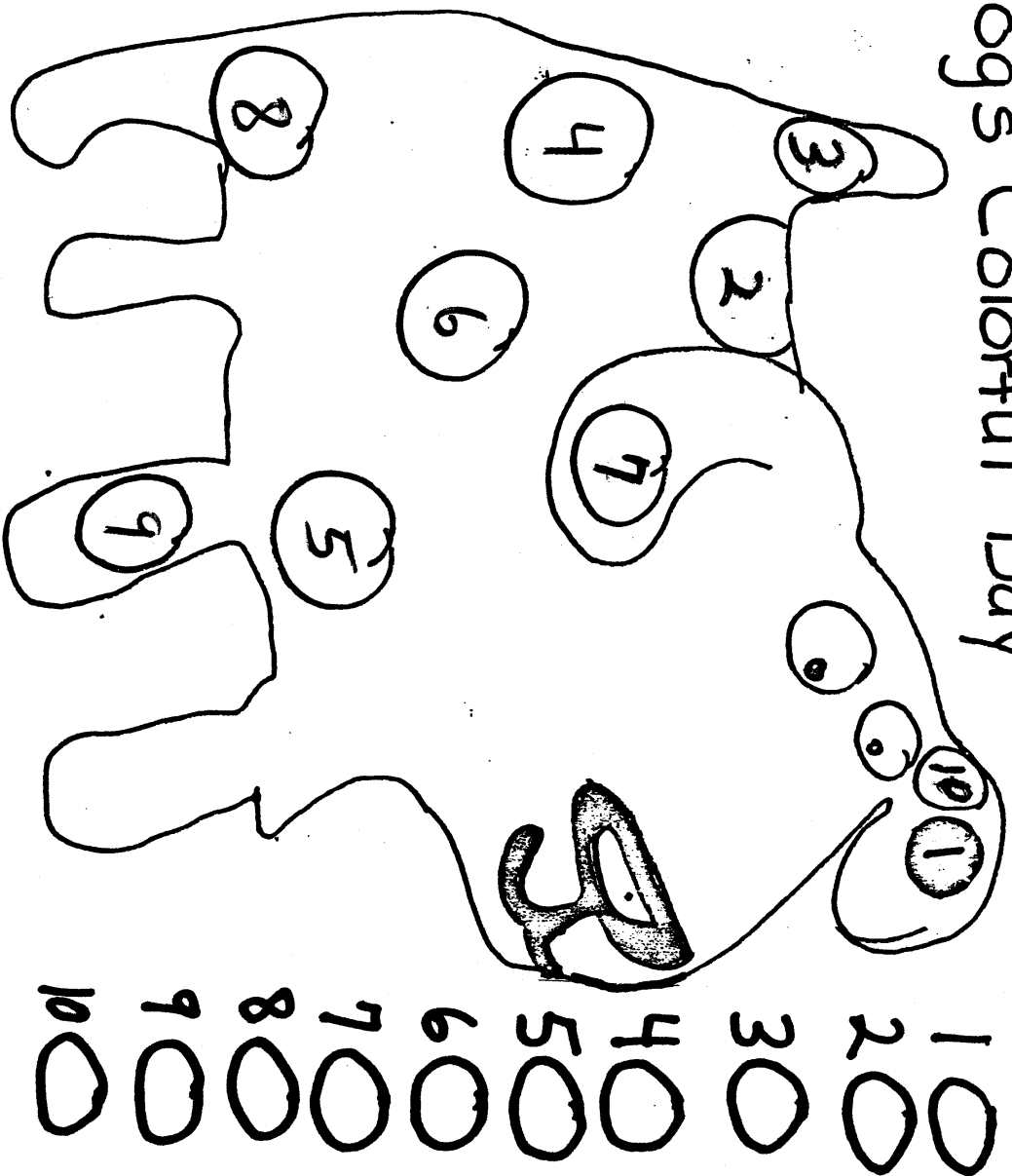


LESSON PLANS

Dog's Colorful Day	
GRADE(S)	Kindergarten
GOALS	Students will know colors, counting from one to 10 and be able to match numbers and colors to a key
ESSENTIAL QUESTION	
STANDARD(S)	ELA, Math, Science
MATERIALS	<u>Dog's Colorful Day</u> by Dodd Worksheet Crayons Felt board copy of worksheet
DESCRIPTION	Read <u>Dog's Colorful Day</u> to the students. Give each student a copy of the worksheet with the key colored in to match the spots Dog got during the day. Students will match the number in the key with the spot on Dog, and color appropriately.
DIFFERENTIATION	Instead of giving individual students a worksheet, enlarge the worksheet on the copier and cut from felt. Cut spots and create key. Use the felt dog and spots with the class after reading the story.
ASSESSMENT	Students will be able to complete worksheet or felt board matching numbers and colors.
