## **Graduation Readiness**

- High School Graduation requires two student/school actions:
  - 1. Schools must "pass" 5 Regents examinations
  - Students must earn a sufficient grade in the required courses and earn the additional credits – 22 – necessary to graduate

#### Local Diploma – minimum of 55% on:


- Math A Regents

- a 2 Social Studies Regents (Global and US)
- Regents Diploma
  - Same 5 as Local Diploma with a minimum of 65%
- Regents Diploma w/advanced designation
  Same 5 as Local Diploma with a minimum score of
- 65% plus:
- Math B
- 1 more Science (one of the two must be Living Environment)
- A Language Other Than English


# Range of Students "On-Track" to Graduate


- 16.2% have passed all five Regents and have at least 22 credits
- 22.5% possess 22 credits
- 41.5% have, at this time, passed all five Regents courses

Note: Data include all seniors and not just cohort 2004; data do not incorporate January '08 Regents exams or credits accumulated during this marking period

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# Next Steps

#### To boost graduation among current seniors:

- Further assess student readiness based on January Regents exams and February 4 report cards
- Target interventions to those seniors who would most benefit:
  - Develop and monitor individual graduation plans
  - Provide extended day, evening, and Saturday sessions
- Offer course reviews and courses in key locations throughout the City
- Provide additional support to students in those schools with the lowest exam passing rates or credit accumulation levels

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
