Ratifying Memorandum of Agreement with the Board of Education Non-Teaching Employees (BENTE)

Whereas, the Board of Education Non-Teaching Employees ("BENTE") and the Rochester City School District ("the District") have entered into a memorandum of agreement amending Appendix A of the collective bargaining agreement for the period July 1, 2004-June 30, 2007 ("the collective bargaining agreement"); and

Whereas, Appendix A of the collective bargaining agreement contains wage brackets for various titles within BENTE; and

Whereas, the above-referenced agreement upgrades the brackets for the titles of Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant in the Primary Unit and Occupational Therapist and Physical Therapist in the Supervisory and Technical Unit and the upgrade is based on the difficulty that the District has had in hiring individuals in these positions; and

Whereas, the above-referenced agreement further provides for a 5% wage increase for current employees in the above-referenced titles; and

Whereas, the above-referenced memorandum of agreement also settles two pending grievances brought by BENTE against the District—Grievance Nos. 337 and 358 on the initial salary placement of new hires in these titles; and

Whereas, the above-referenced memorandum of agreement has an economic consequence for the collective bargaining agreement between the District and BENTE which is substantial and prospective, warranting express ratification by the Board of Education of the Rochester City School District ("the Board of Education"); now therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Board of Education approves the above-referenced agreement with regard to the following economic provisions:

- 1. The title of Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant in the Primary Unit will be moved from bracket 15, which has a salary range of \$13.54-\$15.91, to bracket 17, which has a salary range of \$14.43-16.95.
- 2. The title of Occupational Therapist and Physical Therapist in the Supervisory and Technical Unit will be moved from bracket 23, which has a salary range of \$21.61-\$25.35, to bracket 25, which has a salary range of \$26.52-\$31.13.
- 3. Each BENTE member currently serving in the titles, referenced in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, will receive a 5% wage increase leveled up to the nearest higher step of the new bracket, unless they were hired above their bracket. Those hired above the current bracket will receive no increase unless an increase is necessary to place them on the next higher step in the new bracket.
- 4. BENTE members who are currently paid above the step schedule will receive a 5% increase unless they were hired above the current bracket.
- 5. The pay increases set forth in paragraphs 3 and 4 above are effective as of the first full pay period following adoption of this Resolution and will be prorated for the remaining months of the 2005-2006 school year. The pay increases affect approximately 52 employees.
- 6. The modifications to the collective bargaining agreement and the pay increases set forth in paragraphs 1-5 above settle pending BENTE Grievance Nos. 337 and 358.

Whereas, the Board of Education under several resolutions, and most recently Resolutions 2005-2006: 473, 474, 475, 476 and 477 (December 22, 2005) authorized the establishment and/or continuation of ongoing professional relationships with various outside counsel for a variety of purposes including supplemental legal advice and assistance, or provision of defense services when there is need for separate counsel, as determined by the District's General Counsel; and believes that the District's interests are well served by establishing a nonexclusive relationship with Harris, Beach, LLP., 99 Garnsey Road, Pittsford, New York 14534, for the purpose of providing supplemental legal assistance to the District Law Department for fiscal, environmental or other legal issues which may arise from time to time during the implementation of the proposed facilities modernization plan, as determined necessary by the District's General Counsel and believes such an ongoing support relationship to be beneficial to the District; and wishes to enable the General Counsel to obtain and retain the most favorable possible discounted rates for such services, it is

Resolved, that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the Superintendent of Schools, through the General Counsel to enter a nonexclusive contract relationship retaining the law firm of Harris, Beach LLP., contingent upon such terms and conditions as he deems to be in the District's best interests, for a two-year term, for the purpose of providing legal advice, assistance and representation to the District in areas of practice relating to components of the facilities modernization plan as determined necessary and useful by the District's General Counsel, within the amounts allocated for professional services by the Board for such services on projects approved to implement a facilities modernization plan, or as provided in the annual budget for the Law Department; and it is

Further resolved, that, the General Counsel shall notify the Finance Committee of the Board of Education of the negotiated fee rate(s) and shall not, in any event, incur a liability for said contract (taken together with other professional contracts chargeable to the same budget line) in excess of the amount provided in the District budget for the facilities modernization plan, or any approved component thereof; or in excess of the annual budget of the Law Department for professional contracts.
