WHEREAS, with the adoption of its 2004 budget, the County of Monroe determined that it was no longer positioned to fund or provide school health services to Rochester schools, and that decision has been sustained in decisions of the New York State Supreme Court and the Appellate Division, Fourth Department; and

WHEREAS, within the geographic boundaries of the Rochester City School District there exists a marked concentration of poverty, of racial concentration or isolation, and of limited English language capacity, which together increase the risk that school age children do not have access to any regular or adequate health services outside of school; and that unless the District has express and flexible authority to provide such services directly or through contractors, and to develop an integrated health services network with available community resources, many children within the District are likely to continue to have insufficient access to health care, with the inexorable result that their educational development will also be impaired, to the long term detriment of those children and to the detriment of the City of Rochester and of the State; and

WHEREAS, a key element of the legislative agenda previously recommended by the Community and Intergovernmental Relations Committee and adopted by this Board was to promote a creative and flexible statutory framework to provide health services directly or through BOCES and/or the health services community; to authorize use of emerging technologies and to use strategies which utilize the full range of health care and insurance assets in the community; and to assure maximum possible State reimbursements for such services; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the recommendation of the Community and Intergovernmental Relations Committee that the District seek support and passage of legislation presently named the Integrated Health Services for Fiscally Dependent School Districts Act, which draft has been forwarded in the Committee's report of February 17, 2005;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Rochester City School District supports the aforesaid legislation to provide authority to effectively and creatively address the unique and significant health challenges facing the students of this District; and
