WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2007-08: 45, adopted on July 19, 2007, the Board authorized the Superintendent to enter into a Lease Agreement with Landsman Development Corporation, to lease approximately 178,180 square feet of the four story building located at 30 Hart Street, Rochester, NY, (commonly known as the Family Learning Center), for the period of September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2012, at a monthly rent of Seventy Four Thousand Two Hundred Forty One Dollars and Sixty Six Cents (\$74,241.66) for year one and year two, and a monthly rent of Seventy Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Three Dollars and Ninety Five Cents (\$77,953.95) for year three, year four and year five; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2008-09: 146, adopted on August 28, 2008, the Board of Education authorized the Superintendent to pay, for each remaining year of the Lease Agreement, as additional rent, the District's proportionate share of charges pursuant to the Lease Agreement, including Common Area Maintenance (CAM) charges and property taxes, in an amount not to exceed (\$250,000) each year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Lease Agreement, the District is responsible for utilities and repairs specified in the Lease Agreement; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That all additional charges under the Lease Agreement, including but not limited to Common Area Maintenance (CAM) charges, property taxes, utilities and repairs, shall not exceed Three Hundred Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$335,000) for year three, Three

Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Dollars (\$353,000) for year four, and Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Three Dollars (\$370,753) for year five of the Lease Agreement.
