Resolution Declaring September 2006 Act for Education Month in the Rochester City School District, Rochester, New York

WHEREAS one in three students across New York State do not graduate on time and in many communities the graduation rate is even lower; and

WHEREAS New York State has the largest funding gap between high and low income school districts and one of the highest student achievement gaps; and

WHEREAS the New York State court of Appeals has ruled, in the *Campaign for Fiscal Equity* case, that the State of New York is failing in its constitutional obligation to provide all public school students in New York City with access to a "meaningful high school education," also known as a "sound basic education;" and

WHEREAS New York City schools are not the only schools without adequate resources to provide all students access to a "meaningful high school education" or "sound basic education;" and the constitutional obligation of New York State extends to Rochester students as well as students in New York City; and

WHEREAS the Court of Appeals specified significant increases in school funding are necessary to providing a "meaningful high school education" or "sound basic education;" and

WHEREAS increased education funding, invested in proven educational strategies with clear accountability provisions is a sound strategy to increase educational outcomes; and

WHEREAS the proportion of total school funding in New York provided by the state government is at its lowest level in fifty years; and

WHEREAS the Rochester City School District is prohibited from levying property taxes for educational purposes and must rely upon its host city to do so on its behalf; and

WHEREAS the host city of Rochester is itself facing myriad fiscal pressures there is a tremendous need to provide additional school funding through increased state aid rather than increased local taxes; and

WHEREAS we wish to show support for a statewide resolution of the *Campaign for Fiscal Equity* case that includes a fairer state school aid formula and significant increases in state aid provided to local schools based upon student need combined with accountability to ensure educational results; and
