Setting Board of Education Compensation Effective January 1, 2006 Pursuant to Rochester City Charter § 2-13

Whereas § 2-13 of the Rochester City Charter provides that the annual salary of each Commissioner of Schools and the annual salary of the President of the Board of Education shall be prescribed by the Board of Education, with any changes to take effect on the first day of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, the last adjustment to the salary of the Commissioners of Schools and of the President of the Board of Education was enacted over nineteen (19) years ago, under Resolution No. 85-86:614(13)[May 15, 1986] and effective on July 1, 1986; and

Whereas, during that nineteen-year period, the provisions of Rochester City Charter § 5-2 governing the salaries paid to the members of the Rochester City Council has been amended by Local Law on five occasions between 1988 and 2001 and currently provides for annual salaries which are adjusted on January 1 of each year to reflect any increase in the Consumer Price Index-Urban, up to an annual cap of 3%; while pursuant to Rochester City Charter § 4-1 and Rochester City Code § 5-1 the President of the Council receives both the salary of a City Council member and an additional salary as presiding officer; and

Whereas, the Board Governance and Development Committee of the Board of Education has recommended that the compensation of the Commissioners of Education and the President of the Board of Education be revisited with sufficient lead time to incorporate the figures into the development of the 2006-2007 Budget; and that effective July 1, 2006, the salary paid to Commissioners of Education be set at an amount equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of the salary amount set by the City Charter for members of the City Council; and due deliberation having been had, it is, therefore,

Resolved, that pursuant to the express authority vested in the Board of Education under Rochester City Charter § 2-13, effective July 1, 2006, and on the first day of each fiscal year thereafter, the salary of each Commissioner of Education shall be fixed for the fiscal year at

seventy-five percent (75%) of the salary available to each member of the Rochester City Council under Rochester City Charter § 5-2 for the calendar year in which the District's fiscal year begins; and it is

Further Resolved, that pursuant to the express authority vested in the Board of Education under Rochester City Charter § 2-13, effective July 1, 2006, and on the first day of each fiscal year thereafter, in addition to his/her salary as a Commissioner of Education, the President of the Board of Education shall receive compensation as President which shall be fixed for the fiscal year at seventy-five percent (75%) of the salary established for the President of the Rochester City Council under Rochester City Charter § 4-1 and Rochester City Code § 5-1 for the calendar year in which the District's fiscal year begins.
