Special Meeting Minutes December 8, 2009

Attendance: President Evans, Vice President White, and Commissioners Brennan, Campos, Elliott, Powell, and Williams. General Counsel Charles Johnson and Auditor General Anissa Henry-Wheeler.

President Evans convened the meeting at 5:37 p.m.

President Evans opened the meeting with the discussion of the proposed policy to address the District's Medicaid compliance program.

In considering the proposed policy, the Commissioners discussed the District's total Medicaid revenue and the potential loss in revenue that could occur with noncompliance. The Commissioners agreed to continue the discussion at the Policy Committee meeting scheduled for December 15, 2009.

Commissioner Powell made a motion to consider, Resolution No. 2009-10: 492. The motion was seconded by Vice President White.

President Evans opened the floor for discussion.

Commissioner Powell said the resolution formalizes the Board's intent for handling the leak of the Comptrollers report to the Democrat and Chronicle.
