- o Hand in a Confidential Applicant Snapshot from a past or current teacher.

What you need to bring with you:

- o Your written essay/statement about why you want to attend School of the Arts.
- Your completed *Confidential Applicant Snapshot* (this may be mailed directly to SOTA AUDITIONS)
