YOND'R Pouches for Cell Phones	<p>RCSD has purchased the pouches for our school.</p> <p>Pros and Cons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Need less staff to run the system; reduces burden.• More responsibility on students.• We have never lost a phone using our current system.• There are 7 school that plan to use this system in RCSD.• This is a costly sytem to implement.• Kids could put fake phone in pouch and sneak real phone in but scanning will continue under this system.• Locked all day and unlocked at the end of the day.• Collected at entry and unlocked at dismissal.• Like security tag magnets that are used to secure clothing at the mall.• If pouch is lost, new one will be provided.• If student pouch with phone inside is lost, someone else can open their pouch and take their phone.• Important to be sure phones are off or silenced at entry.• Magnets are removable after entry and before dismissal so they cannot be accessed by kids during the day.• We will need to have extra/loaner pouches for kids who forget their pouch. <p>Need Implementation Team: Ed Mascadri, Kristine Price, 3rd MP RTA collectors and returners, YONDR team</p> <p>Want to roll out in early March so we can get this paid for by RCSD</p>

Targeted Interventions on ZOOM	<p>This is an opportunity for our scholars to get extra help from RTAvJenn Rees is handling this. We have been able to recover some of the funds that were cut. Teachers have been allocated hours to work with kids after school or evenings. They can get 1:1 support if wanted. This is a great way for kids to catch back up.
