Open House Format	<p>We have made some changes to our Open House format due to necessary COVID 19 considerations. Everyone attending Open House must wear a mask unless they are in the cafeteria eating. Masks will be available for families and students upon entry and at the FACE table as well. Staff will be available in their rooms on site during open house (5:30-7pm on 9/23) and parents and students can navigate around the building to meet their teachers/counselors/social workers/administrators/etc. Students & Parents will be given a map to assist them in finding the rooms they seek throughout the building. Staff in classrooms should not receive more than 25 people in a classroom at a time to be mindful of density of gathering per the space. There will be a Hispanic Heritage month celebration and dinner (offered by FACE) in the cafeteria for those students, families and staff who are interested in participating. We will ask all who enter the cafeteria to sign their name on a sheet/form so that we have the ability to contact trace in case that is needed and additionally to assist with ordering food for future celebrations.</p>
