Recommendations

- Show the children the picture on the song card and ask them why we call these instrument hand drums. Show them the hand drum and talk about how the "head" of the drum is really thin, which is why we don't play them with sticks like they do on TV or at church, etc...
- Have students practice ALL of the performance skills by patting on their laps.
- You will likely need to share drums—if so, you may need to model sharing with your TA and/or Paraprofessional. If sharing a drum, it should be played on the floor.
