Quarter 3 continued with a Cats theme as we read a book called ***Copy Cats***. These students drew & painted a cat plus a house for their cat. Next we learned about Snakes and rolled clay coils to create snakes. After the snakes dried, and got fired in the kiln, the artists painted their snakes and a background.

Our PreK 3 & 4 year olds' first experience with real clay was an excellent opportunity to compare/contrast clay and PlayDoh. They learned, "PlayDoh is a toy, and Clay is for Artists. Are you an Artist?" YES!
