		 Agenda Item #5 (Pay Day = Grade Day): Principal Felton laid out a plan to ensure that grades are updated on a consistent basis (by each pay date). Concerns about a new "mandate" were raised. SBPT believes the policy is a best practice and will be "highly recommended." Agenda item will be moved to the "parking lot" to be addressed in the future.
		 Agenda Item #6 (Attendance/Tardiness): Principal Felton discussed school plans for addressing attendance/tardies. SBPT discussed options for tracking attendance. ALMS Policy Tardy-Excused: Student arrives late with an appropriate pass. Tardy-Unexcused: Students that arrive late without a pass. Staff should ensure that attendance is accurate and attendance is updated as students arrive in class. Recommendation made to mark "late bus" on passes for appropriate cases. Important reminder to staff to appropriately mark "Excused" vs "Unexcused" in attendance.
		Agenda Item #7 (New Procedure for Phone Distribution and Dismissal): SBPT discussed the dismissal procedure. The goal is to replicate successes from the 2024-25 school year. Staff discussed the issues with busing and dismissal policy issues early in the year. The new (current) plan has been much more successful.
