- II. Professional Development approvals

- III. Walk-Through and Learning Walk tools will focus on the areas below:
  - Lesson Planning (making sure you have them), Learning Targets,
    Questioning and Discussion Techniques, Differentiation, GRAIR, Step Up to
    Writing, Zearn, Intervention and Morning Meeting (Tier 1 Instruction).

- IV. Step Up to Writing SBPT approved genre studies and utilizing data tracking sheets for grades K-6.
- V. Instructional expectations are in the staff handbook and were previously approved by SBPT.
- VI. GRAIR, Morning Meeting, DEAR
  - a. Add Morning Meetings and DEAR time to the instructional day and to the master schedule
  - Breakfast and Morning Meeting will take place from 9:00-9:30. Core instruction begins at 9:30. Ideally, Morning Meeting should happen at the beginning of the day. But, if it needs to happen at another time it can.
  - c. DEAR time will take place the last 10 minutes of lunch. Students will need to bring a book to lunch.
  - d. GRAIR should happen in the ELA block and be consistent for K-6.

  - Learning Target(s); workshop model: mini lesson, work period, closing; GRAIR; Intervention; Student Groups (differentiated activities for each group); Zearn; small group instruction; assessments (rubrics used, checks for understanding, exit tickets)
