3:54	10	<p>Topic: Being a Writer PD- Upcoming</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● We are piloting Being a Writer in the RCSD (with 2 other schools) ● We have seen incredible improvements in writing since starting Being a Writer. ● The company from Being A Writer came and did a walk through and were so impressed. ● Dec 6th is a half day, we are being given the opportunity to have a virtual PD with Being a Writer; specifically about collaborative planning and diving deeper into the curriculum. ● The issue is that this would end later than our contractual day.
