

HIGH SCHOOL/BOCES ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN

SUNY ERIE COMMUNITY COLLEGE VISION CARE TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT

AND

ROCHESTER CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT East High School 3316 OPHTHALMIC FABRICATION PROGRAM

PURPOSE

This agreement provides the opportunity for students from the High School or BOCES Program to receive course credit for the following course:

• VC 245 - Ophthalmic Fabrication I - 2 credits

TERM

This Agreement shall be effective as of the date last executed by the parties and shall terminate on June 30, 2027.

ADVANTAGE TO STUDENTS:

Elimination of duplication of learning materials reduces the required number of credit hours to take for graduation and provides for a seamless transition between secondary and post-secondary education.

ADMISSION AND ARTICULATION PROCEDURES:

- 1. Students must meet college admission requirements and pass the SUNY Erle Community College Math and English placement tests.
- 2. Before a student registers they must submit a completed SUNY Erie Community College High School Transfer Credit Reference Form signed by their instructors to the SUNY Erie Community College Admissions office (forms are available through the high school/ BOCES teacher or Guidance Office or www.ecc.edu\academics\articulation.asp).
- 3. Candidates for admission must be graduated from their home school and must have completed the program with a cumulative grade of 85% or better in that program or course.
- 4. Students accepted under the articulation agreement must successfully complete the other credit hours of instruction in the SUNY Erie Community College Department for graduation.

5. The course(s) at the High School must be successfully completed between September 1, 2022 through June 30, 2027.

COURSE CREDIT:

As a matriculated SUNY Erie Community College student in the curriculum, upon completion of 2 credit hours of the degree requirements, during the semester, the student will be granted course credits.

This agreement requires the High School or BOCES program to notify a Department Chair of the SUNY Erie Community College Academic Unit of any changes in the Program.

This agreement supersedes any and all previous agreements between the parties and constitutes the full and exclusive agreement of the parties.
