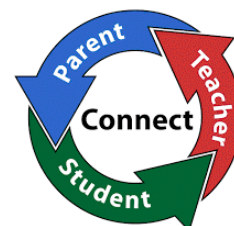

Home School Connection

Ideas to Support Early Literacy Skills

Below is a list of ideas for fostering a strong home/school connection with the families of your students. Create a weekly or monthly calendar with different activities adults and children could do together. The activities can be structured in a way to provide opportunities for families to use the same vocabulary and/or concepts you have been using in your classroom. The possibilities are endless. Some examples are:

- Name 2 things you bring to school.
- Close your eyes. What do you hear?
- Look for 3 *soft* things. Describe how they feel.
- Lift 2 different things. Which is *heavier*? Which is *lighter*?
- Touch the *top* and *side* of your head. Touch the *bottom* of your feet.
- Find 3 things at home that are *wet*. *Where* in your home did you find them?
- Find 2 leaves on the ground. How are they the *same*? How are they *different*?
- Look for 3 things that are *round*.
- Look at the sidewalk. Find the *edge*.
- Get 2 pillows. Go *over*, *under*, and *between* them.
- Look *behind* you. How many things do you see?
- Name 3 foods everyone in your family likes.
- Name 2 things that *rhyme* with cat.
- When you are standing, what is *beneath* you?
- Lay on your back and look up. What is *above* you?
- Find 2 shoes that are *different* sizes.
- Make a *quiet* sound.
- Name 2 *liquids* you like.
- Find 2 things in your house that are *taller* than you.
- Look for the first letter of your name as you go home.
- What do you eat that is *warm*?
- What is the *first* thing you do when you get home from school?
- What is the *last* thing you do before you go to bed?
- Listen to music. Dance *fast* and then dance *slow*.
- Find 2 things that are *green* in your house.
- Find the *biggest* cup in your house.
- Find the *smallest* cup in your house.
- Name something that is *constructed* out of wood.
- How many people live with you?
- Cut a piece of fruit in *half* before you eat it.
- Find 3 things on your body that are in *pairs*.
- Name 2 things you can put on when you are *cold*.
- Make a list of things you do at school.
- *Predict* if tomorrow will be a sunny day.
- Step *over* any lines on the sidewalk.
- Name 4 animals that have a *tail*.
- *Describe* 2 ways you use water.
- What happens *when* it is raining?
- Who is the *oldest* person in your family? Who is the *youngest*?
- Eat a food that *does not* have seeds.

Pre-K begins the path to academic success and we would like to see our Pre K students be the most successful, creative, and well-read scholars ever. Let's make our city proud of the students that it graduates.

This begins with you!

The high school graduation rate is abysmal. ***We can change it!*** Reading is the foundation for learning and it begins in the home at birth. It takes both the family and the schools to work together to prepare our children for Kindergarten. **Did you know that experts say that children need to hear at least 1,000 stories before they begin to learn how to read?**

This year we challenge each family to accomplish the goal of

1,000 Books before Kindergarten

Sounds like a lot of reading, but it is very manageable. What an accomplishment if we can all work together and achieve this goal. Your child will be on the road to academic success. Let's prove that we can do it!

**This will be the 'daily homework' for Pre-K this year.
Family participation is crucial to the success of this program.
Here's how it works:**



Your family will be given a sheet to record the books your child reads with you or another family member. Read 3-4 books per day including books read in the classroom to meet the goal. Preschool level books are short and have many pictures.



Any Book Counts!

- Any complete book counts.
- A favorite book can be read multiple times. (repetition is necessary for learning)
- Anyone can read the books: teachers, family members, day care, and friends.



When Can I Find Time to Read?

- At arrival time in school; Waiting in Car; Waiting for a doctor's appointment;
- Waiting for bus; Before bed every night; In morning before school; After dinner
- Read instead of watching TV; Alternate 15 minutes computer games/15 minutes reading;
- Read an eBook; Library Story Time.



Reading Log

Take a special moment each day with your child to write down the titles. If you read the same book multiple times, just put check marks after the title. When the page is filled up, count up the books and you will receive a new sheet.



Where Do I Get Books?

- Go to the Library; Borrow from our classroom library; Swap with friends.

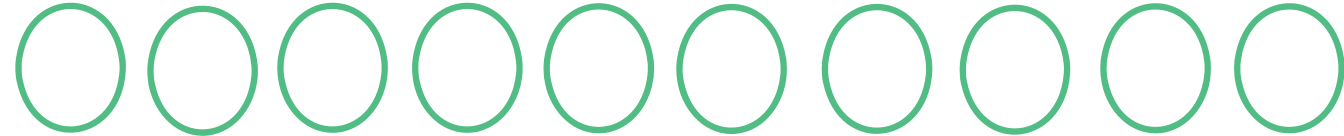
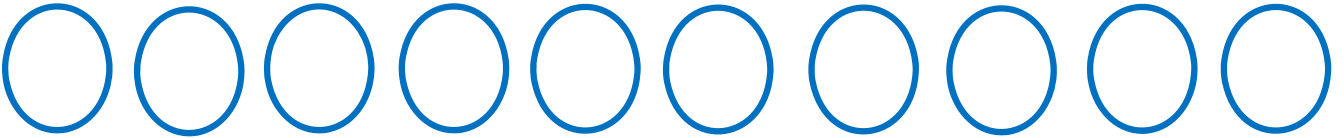

¡Lea, Lea, Lea!!

- ¡Lea 10 libros por semana por 2 años = 1040 libros! (Clase PM de 3 años)
- Lea 3 libros por semana por 1 año = 1095 libros! (Clase AM de 4 años)



¡Cualquier Libro Cuenta!

- Cualquier libro completo (o capítulo de un libro) cuenta.
- Un libro favorito puede ser leído varias veces. (la repetición es necesaria para el aprendizaje). Cualquiera puede leer los libros: maestros, miembros de la familia, cuidadores de guardería y amigos.
