Student Device Policy: No iPads or Unauthorized Devices

Effective immediately, students are not permitted to bring iPads to school. This policy is in place to maintain a focused learning environment, safety and to prevent distractions. District Chromebooks are the officially assigned devices for students, equipped with a monitoring program to ensure safe usage and protect student data.

Policy Guidelines:

1. **Prohibited Device:** iPads and similar tablet devices are not allowed on school premises during school hours.
2. **Exceptions:** If an iPad is required for a specific educational purpose, prior approval must be obtained from the school administration.
3. **Consequences:**
 - **First Offense:** The device will be confiscated and returned at the end of the school day.
 - **Second Offense:** A parent or guardian must pick up the device from the school office.
 - **Repeated Offenses:** Further disciplinary action may be taken at the discretion of the administration.
4. **Responsibility:** The school is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged devices brought in violation of this policy.

Student Policy: No Stanley Cups/Oversized Water Cups/Unopened Containers

Effective immediately, students are not permitted to bring Stanley Cups, oversized water cups or opened water bottles to the Edison Campus. This policy is implemented to prevent the concealment of cell phones, unauthorized items or inappropriate liquids.

Policy Guidelines:

- 1. Prohibited Item:** Stanley Cups, similar oversized tumblers and opened water bottles/containers are not allowed on school premises during school hours.
- 2. Allowed Alternatives:** Students may bring **clear** unopened plastic containers or unopened water bottle.
- 3. Consequences:**
 - **First Offense:** The cup will be confiscated and returned at the end of the school day.
 - **Second Offense:** A parent or guardian must pick up the cup from the school office.
 - **Repeated Offenses:** Additional disciplinary actions may be taken as determined by school administration.
- 4. Responsibility:** The school is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged cups brought in violation of this policy.
