









The Ant and the Grasshopper

"Come sing with me," the grasshopper said whenever he saw the ant.


The ant's answer was always the same.


"I can't stop now," he said.

But the ant kept working.






What do you predict will happen in this story? Highlight the details that make you think that.

Highlight the details that help you correct or confirm your prediction.




One winter day, the grasshopper went to look for food.

The grasshopper knocked on the ant's door.


He asked for some food.




Underline the grasshopper's problem.
