Agenda was shared with SBPT. 8th graders have been provided this information about the programs via Zoom) Edison has been giving tours and has received positive feedback and students are choosing Edison first.</p> <p>Who has heard of the ROC auto tech program? It started yesterday. Adults are participating. This is the first adult learning program we have had in over 25 years. 10 slots will be open for Edison graduates, We currently have a waiting list. For now we will need to keep it to 25. Our goal is to also include Machine Tech by the fall.</p> <p>Cosmetology is still of interest, but we are currently looking for someone who can do it here. Trying to share instructors so we can have a program during the afternoon instead of evening.</p> <p>We will have members of community to be on panel for Women's Wretches Days</p> <p>Had a State visit today, via Zoom. Sarah Sweet shared an email regarding strategies and new entrants to Edison. Scott had sent an email regarding students who are off track. We have received 102 new entrants. Since January 2023, we have received 65. Scott - Can the district provide a list of new entrants/placements for all schools.</p> <p>Harris - We receive ELL who choose Edison as 3rd because other schools are not able to provide appropriate support.
