			<p>Employability continues to be a focus. We need a comprehensive review plan for Regents classes. Scheduling lab qualified students for science Regents exams. Identifying and prioritizing exams for students in need. Co Teaching/co planning and formative assessment will round out the year for the after school PDs.</p> <p>Pass/Fail review classes can be problematic - need to work on how to help students stick with it.</p> <p>Getting student Regents schedules as soon as practicable so students will be aware and feel more ready for June.</p> <p>Safety Net - while it helps students graduate, it does not help accountability data. We need a conversation around students taking tests they need and sitting for tests they've gotten the Special Appeal credit for.</p> <p>It was brought up that we should use the 3/3 half day PD to look at recent data (Regents/midterms, etc)/item analysis to get ready for June.</p> <p>Possibly call a special SBPT meeting - Wednesday 2/8 to plan 3/3 half-day.</p>
