Minutes

Attendance: President Evans and Board Clerk Shanai Lee.

President Evans opened the hearing at 6:05 p.m.

President Evans stated that Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and regulations of the Commissioner of Education 8 N.Y.C.R.R. § 119.4 require the Board to conduct a public hearing within 30 days of receipt of notice of an application for a new charter school.

President Evans explained that the Board is holding a hearing to gather public input regarding the renewal of the charter application for the Rochester Academy Charter School. The proposed renewal extends the dates of operation from January 15, 2013 through June 30, 2017 and enables the school to accommodate additional grade levels and students. The Rochester Academy Charter School will have grades 7-12 in the 2012-13 school year, with a projected enrollment of 360 students and by the 2016-17 school year, the school anticipates an enrollment of 735 students in grades K-12.

President Evans then requested public input and questions regarding this school.

No speakers were present.
