As your Middle El. teachers, we want you to be prepared for September! Over the summer please remember to continue to practice the following skills:

Writing- write EVERYDAY! Create stories, research animals and places, whatever you write about please remember to engage your reader, give details in sequential order and don't forget to close your writing with a great ending by expressing feeling. Also, make sure you are writing complete sentences with capitals at the beginning of your sentence and punctuation at the end of each sentence.

Math-Practicing 2-3 digit multiplication and long division are KEY! These skills go hand in hand and by practicing these skills over the summer you are going to be READY for 5th grade.

KNOW YOUR MULTIPLICATION FACTS 0-10! By knowing your facts fluently, you are going to move faster through new math concepts. *Flash cards can be purchased at the Dollar Tree.*

ELA- READ EVERY DAY! Build your reading stamina by reading 30 minutes each day! Always think about who, what, where and WHY things are happening in the books you are reading. Visit the library- they offer programs you can join over the summer as well as a variety of books that you may be interested in checking out.
