WHEREAS, Section 54F of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), as added by Section 1521(a) of Title I of Division B of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Tax Act of 2009, Pub. L. No. 111-5, 123 Stat. 114, 355-57 (2009), authorizes the issuance of “qualified school construction bonds” as a type of qualified tax credit bond under Section 54A of the Code, for the purpose of financing, among others, the construction, rehabilitation or repair of public school facilities (“Qualified School Construction Bonds”); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 54F(d)(2) of the Code and Internal Revenue Service Notice 2009-35, 2009-17 I.R.B. 876 (Apr. 27, 2009) (the “Notice”) the Rochester City School District, Monroe County, NY (the “District”), as a “large educational agency” within the meaning of Section 54F(d)(2) of the Code, had received an allocation of \$29,535,000 from the national limitation on the amount of Qualified School Construction Bonds for calendar year 2009 (the “2009 QSCB Allocation”); and

WHEREAS, under Sections 54F(d)(2)(D) and 54F(e) of the Code, prior to the Amendment (as defined and described below), the District’s 2009 QSCB Allocation, or any portion thereof, could either have been (i) allocated by the District to Qualified School Construction Bonds issued by or for the benefit of the District in calendar year 2009 or (ii) reallocated by the District to the State of New York (the “State”), for application by the State to Qualified School Construction Bonds to be issued in the current or any future calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the District did not anticipate that it would have been able to allocate or itself carry over the 2009 QSCB Allocation to Qualified School Construction Bonds to be issued by or for the benefit of the District in calendar year 2009 or a future calendar year; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid a loss of the 2009 QSCB Allocation, the District duly adopted Resolution No. 2009-10: 470, at a meeting of the Board of Education of the District held on December 17, 2009, reallocating all of the 2009 QSCB Allocation to the State under Section 54F(d)(2)(D) of the Code (the “Reallocation Resolution”) with the intent and expectation that the State would reallocate the 2009 QSCB Allocation to the District for allocation to Qualified School Construction Bonds to be issued by the District in the current year or any future calendar year; and

WHEREAS, Section 54F of the Code was amended on March 18, 2010, by Section 301(b)(2) of the Hiring Incentives to Restore Employment Act, Pub. L. No. 111-147, 124 Stat. 71, 78 (2010), (the “Amendment”) to effectively provide that a “large educational agency”, such as the District, could itself carry over to the following calendar year any of its allocation of the national limitation on the amount of Qualified School Construction Bonds not allocated by such “large educational agency” to Qualified School Construction Bonds issued by or for its benefit in a given calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment took effect as if it were included in Section 1521 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Tax Act of 2009 as originally enacted; and

WHEREAS, under Sections 54F(d)(2) and 54F(e) of the Code, as amended by the Amendment, the District’s 2009 QSCB Allocation, or any portion thereof, would carry over to the current year for the District to allocate or carry over to Qualified School Construction Bonds

in the current year or a future calendar year, unless it had either been (i) allocated by the District to Qualified School Construction Bonds issued by or for the benefit of the District in calendar year 2009 or (ii) reallocated by the District to the State of New York (the "State"), for application by the State to Qualified School Construction Bonds to be issued in the current or any future calendar year; and
