Resolved, that the President of the Board of Education and the Superintendent of Schools or their designee be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into an agreement with Hamilton, Rabinovitz & Alschuler, Inc., to provide consulting services for a nationwide search for the position of Superintendent of Schools, for a sum not to exceed \$100,000 (one hundred thousand dollars) for the period beginning upon execution of the agreement and terminating upon the appointment of a Superintendent of Schools, contingent upon the form and terms of the agreement having been approved by Counsel to the City School District.
