DISTRICT POLICY AGAINST HARASSMENT OF STUDENTS OR EMPLOYEES

1510.00 GENERAL POLICY OVERVIEW

The Board of Education strictly prohibits conduct that constitutes harassment in any form because of sex, race, religion, color, age, national origin, disability, sexual orientation or veteran status. The Board of Education is committed to eliminating illegal harassment based on these factors. You are encouraged to bring any concerns regarding possible harassment to the attention of the Building Principal or the Director of Human Resources as Compliance Officer. The District strictly prohibits retaliation against anyone who complains of harassment, or participates in investigations of such complaints. While it is not possible to guarantee that no person will act in a retaliatory manner, it is the policy of the District to (a) make good faith efforts to discourage retaliatory behaviors on its property; and (b) to investigate allegations of retaliation in a fair and equitable manner. The District makes no promise or warranty about the outcome of any specific investigation, nor any promise or assurance that it will exercise its discretion in a manner which meets the desires or preferences of any complainant.

It is the responsibility of all Rochester City School District officers, employees and students to ensure that their behavior and environment are maintained free of harassment.

The Board does expect District constituencies to approach the subject of harassment against a standard of common sense. For example, administrators or teachers, using professional judgment, may touch young students to support, reassure, and celebrate. Also as an example, athletes and coaches might engage in a round of hugs and “high-fives” on the field, when celebrating a victory. It is understood that such touching must be clearly nonsexual in nature, and should not occur away from the sight of others, or in an inappropriate location. By way of further example, an isolated verbal remark, for example, which is not repeated or continued over objection, may not necessarily constitute harassment. A single intentional and serious statement, threat or act, on the other hand, may warrant a wholly different analysis.

1510.01 Harassment of Students

The Board is committed to safeguarding the right of all students within the school district to learn in an environment in which all forms of harassment are strongly discouraged. The Board recognizes that harassment can originate from peers as well as employees, board members or any individual who foreseeably might come in contact with students on school grounds or at school-sponsored activities.

Any student who believes that he or she has been subjected to harassment on the basis of race, sex, religion, color, national origin, disability, or sexual orientation should report the alleged misconduct immediately, pursuant to the Regulations adopted by the Superintendent of Schools, so that any warranted corrective action may be taken. In the absence of a complaint, the Superintendent or his/her designee upon learning of harassment, or having reason to suspect the occurrence of such misconduct will ensure that an investigation is promptly commenced by appropriate individuals.

1510.02 Harassment of Employees

Every employee is entitled to work in an environment in which all forms of harassment are strongly discouraged. It is the policy of the Board to prohibit harassment on the basis of race, religion, color, age, national origin, disability, sexual orientation or veteran status. All employees of the Rochester City School District share the responsibility to model appropriate behavior to ensure that the work place is free from harassment. Employees are required to refrain from conduct that may reasonably be perceived as harassment by co-workers, students, parents and guardians, vendors, consultants or suppliers. .

Employees are encouraged to report incidents that may constitute harassment immediately pursuant to the Regulations adopted by the Superintendent of Schools pursuant to this policy. Each complaint will be treated in a manner that is serious, sensitive, appropriate and confidential to the extent reasonably possible and compatible with investigative discretion.

1510.1 WHAT CONSTITUTES HARASSMENT?

Harassment, generally speaking, is a form of discrimination as set forth in federal and state law. It can include a wide range of behaviors, in various contexts, ranging from unwelcome remarks to acts which constitute criminal conduct (e.g., rape, assault, hate crimes, etc.) which may entail criminal proceedings and penalties.

1510.11 Examples of Sexual Harassment

Sexual harassment has been defined by governmental agencies and the courts as unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature when:

- Submission to, or rejection of such conduct is made, either explicitly or implicitly, a term or condition of a student's academic, cocurricular or extracurricular progress; or as the basis for employment decisions;
- The purpose or effect of the unwelcome verbal or physical conduct unreasonably interferes with work performance or creates an intimidating, hostile or offensive environment.

Thus, sexual harassment, which applies to opposite sex and same sex victims, **may** include, but is not limited to:

- Unwelcome sexual advances;
- Unwelcome suggestive contact of any kind (for example, intimate physical contact; unnecessarily rough or physical contact of a sexual nature; or repeated offensive sexual flirtations, advances or propositions);
- Unwelcome sexually oriented verbal comments (for example, graphic verbal commentaries about an individual's body; sexually degrading words used to describe an individual; or repeated jokes about sex, orientation, or gender-specific traits);
- Subtle pervasive or repeated pressure for sexual activity;
- Demands for sexual favors accompanied by promises or threats including insinuations that refusal to such favors will adversely affect

academic progress of a student, or the evaluation, wages, advancement, assignment, or other conditions of employment or career development of any employee;

- Display of offensive sexually-oriented pictures, posters, etc.
- Unwelcome or repeated intentional non-verbal suggestive or threatening actions such as throwing kisses, making gestures, winking or stalking.

1510.12 Examples of Other types of harassment.

Prohibited conduct includes, but is not limited to the following examples:

- Telling jokes that could reasonably be construed as having a negative racial, ethnic or religious meaning or tone;
- Making inappropriate comments that could reasonably be construed as intending a negative racial, ethnic, or religious meaning or tone;
- Using offensive racial, ethnic, sexual, gender orientation-based or religious names, stereotypes, or threats even if an individual from the racial, ethnic, gender, sexual orientation or religious group is not present;
- Graffiti of this nature in a school building or in the workplace;
- Distributing or displaying written or graphic material that shows hostility or aversion toward an individual or group because of race, color, religion, age, disability, etc.
- Refusal to make reasonable accommodations for the demonstrable religious needs of an employee or student with respect to such matters as scheduling and assignments.

1510.20 RETALIATION & FALSE CLAIMS

Reasonable actions will be taken to prevent retaliation against anyone making a good-faith complaint of harassment or who participates in investigations of such complaints. The District will investigate allegations of retaliation made by any complainant or witness. The District may take such steps as are reasonably appropriate to the findings of such investigations.

Where the District has reason to believe that a claim of harassment or a claim of retaliation is false; or that a claim has been made in bad faith, or with a malicious intent, the District expressly reserves the right to make such inquiries as it deems appropriate, and to exercise its discretion regarding discipline or other consequences for assertion of a false or malicious claim.

1510.30 REGULATIONS & ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY

- 1510.31. Promulgation of Regulations. The responsibility for developing, publishing and enforcing regulations to implement the Board's Policy against Harassment, including complaint procedures, and investigation procedures), rests with the Superintendent of Schools, as authorized by Board of Education Policy # 3310. Such regulations should adhere to all applicable federal or state laws and regulations. The

Superintendent of Schools, with the advice and counsel of the District's Department of Law is expressly authorized to prepare, update, maintain and implement administrative regulations specifically addressing compliance with Titles VII and IX of the Civil Rights Law. Such regulations shall cross-reference this Policy, and shall be disseminated to students and to staff in a manner(s) reasonably designed to assure accessibility.

- 1510.32. Compliance Officer. Under the Regulations to be adopted by the Superintendent, a Compliance Officer shall be designated to carry out the District's responsibilities associated with compliance with federal law.
- 1510.33. Collective Bargaining & District Code of Conduct. The provisions of this Policy shall be deemed to be independent of, and supplemental to, the provisions of collective bargaining agreements between the District and its unions relative to grievance procedures, and to terms and conditions of employment; and to the standards of conduct and disciplinary rules set forth in the District Code of Conduct (Policy 5300). Any employee discipline imposed under this Policy upon an individual covered by a collective bargaining agreement will be done in a manner consistent with the discipline provisions of such agreement and subject to the grievance provisions of such agreement, unless a different approach is mandated by federal or state law or regulation. The foregoing shall not be construed, however, as a limitation upon the right of the District to pursue criminal law remedies when there is evidence of commission of a crime under federal or state law.
- 1510.34. No Special Duty Assumed by District. This Policy, and any Regulations adopted to implement it, are designed and intended to meet the requirements of federal and state law, and to provide the framework for the District's overall approach for the *collective* benefit of its students and employees. Nothing in this Policy or in accompanying regulations shall be construed as limiting any interest or right of action available under federal or state law, nor shall this Policy or accompanying regulations be deemed or construed to create or expand any new or additional interest or right of action in favor of any person or group. Nothing in this Policy or accompanying regulations shall be deemed or construed to offer or promise a special duty of any nature or type to any individual or group, upon which such person or group may rely to their detriment.
- 1510.35. Repealer. Upon adoption of this Policy, and promulgation of regulations by the Superintendent of Schools, Policy 5020.1 "Sexual Harassment of Students" and Policy 9110.2 "Sexual Harassment of Employees" and all regulations relating thereto shall be deemed to be superceded, and of no force and effect for any claim arising after the

effective date of this Policy and associated administrative Regulations. Said Policies and Regulations shall be removed from the Board of Education Policy Manual.

The list of authorized positions attached hereto shall be subject to review and modification by the Board of Education, in its discretion; and expressly supercedes designations appearing in any resolution of this Board prior to this enactment.
