COMMEMORATION OF THE U.S. SUPREME COURT'S 1954 DECISION
BROWN V. BOARD OF EDUCATION

Whereas, May 17, 2004 marks the fiftieth anniversary of the landmark decision of the United States Supreme Court in *Brown v. Board of Education of Topeka*, using cases arising in the States of Kansas, Delaware, Virginia and South Carolina to overrule the long-standing "separate but equal" doctrine, and to assert that segregation based solely upon race violates the 14th Amendment of the United States Constitution; and
