True North Genesee Charter School

Attendance: President Evans, Commissioner Powell, and Board Clerk Shanai Lee.

President Evans opened the hearing at 5:33 p.m.

President Evans stated that Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and regulations of the Commissioner of Education 8 N.Y.C.R.R. § 119.4 require the Board to conduct a public hearing within 30 days of receipt of notice of an application for a new charter school.

President Evans explained that the True North Genesee Charter School has filed a proposal to change its name to “True North Rochester Preparatory Charter – West Campus” with the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York. The school continues its plans to be located in the Rochester City School District with a planned opening in September 2011, 1st year enrollment/grades served of 78 students in grade 5; and 5th year enrollment/grades served of 594 students in grades K-3 and 5-8.

No speakers were present.
