President White convened the Committee of the Whole as a Special Meeting at 5:39p.m.

A **motion** was made by Commissioner Sheppard to suspend article 10 of the bylaws so that all speakers on the speakers list be allowed to address the board for 2 minutes at the current meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Lebron. **Adopted 6-0**, with Commissioner Hallmark absent.

# **II.** Special Meeting Discussion Items

# Superintendent Update

Superintendent Dade addressed the Board for the purpose of providing an update on the District's budget and to provide clarity to the Board and the general public about the collaborative efforts being made. By way of PowerPoint presentation, Superintendent Dade presented a chronology of his meetings with union leadership and lobbying efforts demonstrated to address the budget shortfall. He noted that serious lobbying efforts need to be continued to acquire the additional funds for closing the budget.

# **III.** Finance Committee of the Whole Meeting:

President White surrendered the rest of the meeting Commissioner Powell as Chair of the Board's Finance and Resource Allocation (Finance) Committee at approximately 8:09 p.m. Commissioner Powell briefly shared with the Board re her attendance at the NYSSBA Executive Meeting on the previous weekend.

**Motion** by President White to approve the Minutes of the October 15, 2019 Finance COW

Meeting and the Minutes of the November 12, 2019 Finance COW Meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Lebron. **Adopted 6-0 with Commissioner Hallmark absent.** 

# **Budget Calendar**

The Commissioners reviewed the first draft of the 2020-21 Budget Review Calendar. Vice President Elliot noted a desire to have the Budget Town Halls take place in the community (in the quadrants).

**Motion** by President White to accept the 2020-21 Budget Calendar with the understanding that dates may be changed. Seconded by Commissioner Lebron. **Adopted 6-0 with Commissioner Hallmark absent.** 

Vice President Elliot left the meeting at 8:22 p.m. and returned at 8:27 p.m.

# Review and Discuss Financial Reports

The Committee decided to table consideration of the 2019-20 First Quarter Student Activity Funds and Elementary Activity Accounts Report to allow the Commissioners additional time to review the document. The report will be presented in the next Special meeting: policy COW on December 17, 2019.

The Financial Reports were presented by Chief of Staff, Annmarie Lehner and (Acting) Budget Director, Brian Pack. Commissioner posed several questions regarding the reports.

Of particular note is VP Elliott's query re the accuracy of the financial numbers presented to the Board in each of the reports. Superintendent Dade responded noting that the reports are unaudited but that a thorough review of the financial data had taken place. Commissioner Lebron also noted her concern with the reports being presented with a sign off from the Chief of Staff and not the CFO.

# **Action Item:**

President White requested that the budget team develop a more user-friendly format of the financial reports to allow for the Board and the public to follow more easily.

Motion by President White to forward the November 2019 Financial Report to the December 19, 2019 Board Business Meeting for approval. Seconded by Vice President Elliott. Adopted 4-2 with Commissioner Lebron and Commissioner Davis dissenting and Commissioner Hallmark absent.

Seconded by President White. **Adopted 4-2 with Commissioner Lebron and Commissioner Davis dissenting and Commissioner Hallmark absent.**
