## **Important Reminders:**

- Please be sure your preschooler dresses correctly for the weather. Children go outside in warm and cold (snowy) temperatures.
- Preschool is messy! You will want to dress your child in play clothes.
- Belts, for both boys and girls, are difficult for youngsters to handle when they are in a hurry. Please leave belts at home.
- Please bring in a change of clothes for your child—you can leave a set in the classroom. You will want to check your child's backpack every day for any announcements, work your child has done in class or soiled clothing.
- Please bring a blanket for rest time.
- Be sure to write your child's name on any items brought to school! There are often similar items, such as sippy cups, backpacks, coats, etc.
- If you wish to bring in a snack for the end of the day, speak to you child's teacher.
